

The 2020 NDNA Education Foundation Summer College D.J. Shults Internships

Receive \$2,500 to help hire a student to work with you this summer. Here are the basic rules:

- 1. Student must have completed grade 12.
- 2. Internship requires the equivalent of a minimum of eight weeks of full-time work this summer, and student must be involved in supervised news work.
- 3. Newspaper must select own intern, but NDNA may have some students to refer.
- 4. The Foundation will pay the \$2,500 to the newspaper. The Foundation cannot make payments directly to an individual. The newspaper will supplement the stipend at a level that will result in the student being compensated the equivalent of minimum wage or more.
- 5. A journalism-related major is not required, but will likely get priority consideration if there are a number of applicants.
- 6. Priority will also be given to newspapers that have not received internship stipends in recent years.
- 6. Deadline for application is April 3, 2020. Selections will be announced in mid April.
