The newspaper field seemed to be the gain of Mike, however, as the 22-year-old father said he hoped it would be here that Mike would find his happiness.


Next in line comes law and investigative work.


"I hope he'll be a politician someday, but a good one."


Tracing his own background, Gackle hoped Mike would grow up in a small North Dakota town and enjoy the pleasures of his father.
